- **gba-pilot-disclaimer**: This cookie is used to track your acknowledgment of disclaimers or messages on our website.

#### 2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- Improve Website Performance: To understand how visitors interact with our website, identify areas for improvement, and optimize our content and services.
- Personalize User Experience: To enhance the user experience by providing content and advertisements tailored to your preferences.
